Alokaya

Alokaya was a community service project jointly organised by the Social Service Club of Bishop's College, The United Nations Club of Bishop's College and the Interact Club of Bishop's College. The project focused on planning a fun day and formal lunch for the service and support staff of our school along with their families.





Ottrumai

Ottrumai is an annual project initiated by the Interact Club of Bishop's College where we travel out of Colombo to visit an orphanage that is in need of help, with the purpose of building reconciliation between the Sinhala and Tamil ethnic groups. The club donated dry rations and essential items along with sanitary napkins to the Maliyadeva Girls Development Center in Kurunagala. The club members also visited the Annai Saratha Children's Home in Trincomalee and donated care packs to them as well.

This project is dedicated toward supporting Cancer patients through various activities that include spreading awareness as well as other fun minor games and craft sessions. This project was a volunteer project conducted with the partnership of the Indira Cancer Trust.





Avail



New and gently used clothing and toys from the student body were collected and donated to multiple homes and orphanages. We partnered with several orphanages and elders' homes, ensuring that the donated items reached those who would benefit most.

White Elephant stall

Project White Elephant Stall is an annual initiative organized by our club to support the elderly community in Sri Lanka. Through this project, we collect gently used clothing items such as sarees, sarongs, and kurtas, which are then distributed to various elders' homes.

Bid for lives

Bid for lives was a project under the avenue of Community Service where club members brought in hand crafts to school and members of the school staff and students bid on the crafts with dry rations which were then donated to underprivileged communities.
