Luminara '25

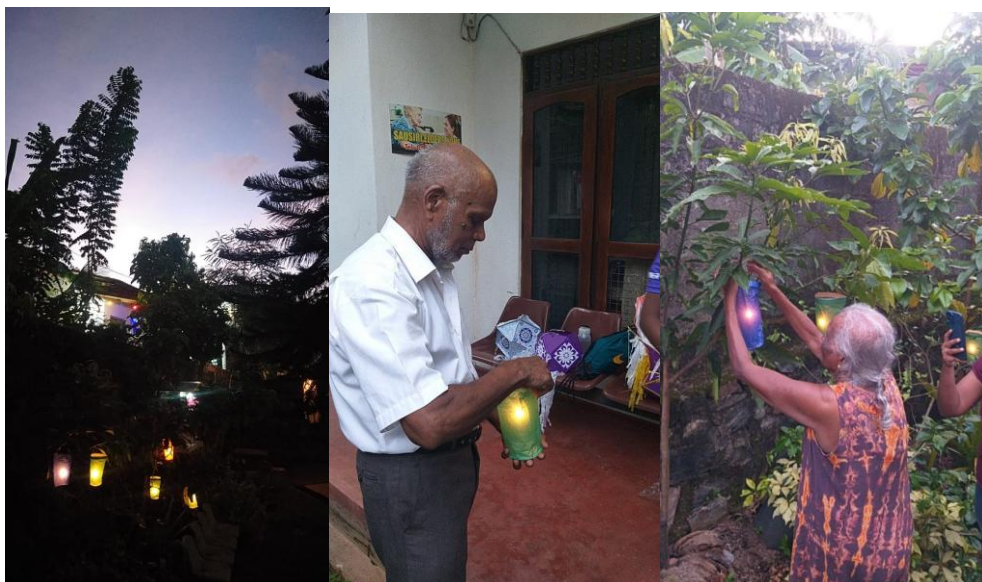
Club name - Social Service Club
